# **Orientation Day:**

On this day, students will meet their Pastoral Leader, engage with learning in the Elective subjects, tour the College facilities and participate in 'ice breakers' to form new relationships. Students are to wear their current school sports uniform and are asked to bring their Morning Tea and Lunch. Please arrive by 9:00am, where students will be directed to the Chisholm Centre; pick-up is from 2:00pm.

## First Day, 2025:

- School commences on **Wednesday**, **29**<sup>th</sup> **January 2025** for all Year 7 students. Students are to meet at Melaleuca at 8:30am.
- On the first day, students should arrive in their full Formal Uniform.
- Students will need to bring their Chisholm Catholic College school bag, their pencil case and stationery, and half of their books. The other books can remain at home and be brought in when needed. The Stationery List is available in the documents list using the QR Code.
- We will provide your son/daughter with a College 'combination lock' on their first day. Students can keep their books in their lockers overnight / over the weekends. They are only required to take home their books that they need to complete homework/assignment work.

## **Textbooks:**

Chisholm Catholic College runs a Textbook Hire Scheme. All Textbooks will be issued to students over the first days of their schooling.



# **College Uniform:**

Formal Uniform is to be worn to and from school every day except for Tuesday and Thursday when Sports Uniforms are to be worn. On days except Tuesday and Thursday, Sports uniforms will need to be brought to school when students have Health and Physical Education (HPE) lessons (Chisholm Sport kit bags are available from The School Locker).
