Tutor Options:

- ◆ Availability depends on the number of students enrolling in a particular instrument.
- ◆ Sectional group ensemble opportunities are available in select circumstances .

Instrumental Variety:

- ◆ Choose from a diverse range of instruments , including guitar, bass guitar, piano and drums.
- ◆ Availability of strings, woodwind, and brass lessons is contingent upon tutor availability.

Materials and Responsibility:

- ◆ Tutor books are responsibility of both students and parents, to purchase as advised by their Tutors.
- ◆ It is essential for students to promptly notify of any absences, including exams, school camps, events.
- ◆ Students are required to present their Music Passes to teachers during scheduled lessons. (provided upon enrolment)

Enrolment Details:

- ◆ Minimum enrolment period is one term (8-10 weeks).
- ◆ Lesson times for selected instruments follow a rotational timetable to accommodate all students. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate every student's request for lessons to be before/after school or during lunch
